



Marshalltown Area Soccer Club – Uniform Policy



The following is the uniform policy for both recreational and traveling MASC teams as noted. Teams are designated as traveling or recreational by the registrar. This policy does not apply to teams that may choose to participate in tournaments outside of league play.

All new teams must abide by this policy.

All existing teams must abide by this policy by the Fall season of 2020.

1. Purpose

- For Marshalltown Area Soccer Club (MASC) our goal regarding uniforms is to present a consistent cohesive TEAM environment that presents a positive representation of the club to both our community and the greater soccer community within the region.
- In order to preserve and protect this recognition, all teams, whether recreational or traveling, shall follow the uniform policy for all games. Ensuring that all teams are readily identified as representing Marshalltown Area Soccer Club (MASC).

2. General

- Per Iowa Soccer Association, all players must wear shin guards and soccer socks that completely cover the shin guards.
- Players may not wear jewelry at any time on the soccer field, except for medical bracelets, which must be taped so as not to snag on clothing during a game.
- Players are not to wear hooded sweatshirts or attire with loose hanging strings, due to the risk of these strings being snagged and causing injury.

3. Uniform Requirements for Recreational U6 – U10

- All U6 – U10 recreational players are required to have soccer socks, shorts/pants, and uniform jersey.
- All players must purchase the required uniform jerseys from MASC. Each season will have announced locations and times for the purchase of jerseys. In addition, throughout the season, the jerseys will be available for purchase thru the concession stand. Uniform jerseys are reversible with royal blue and white. The home team will be blue, and the away team will be white, according to the published schedule.
- In addition, soccer socks and shorts are available for purchase as a kit at the same time as purchase of the uniform jersey.

- Soccer socks and shorts/pants may be purchased elsewhere. The color of the socks/shorts/pants is recommended to be royal blue but is not required based on availability. The reversible uniform jersey must be purchased from MASC.

4. Uniform Requirements for Traveling U10 – U19

- All players on traveling U10- U19 teams are required to have soccer socks, soccer shorts, and a primary and secondary uniform jersey.
- Generally, the primary uniforms will be worn for home game, and the secondary uniforms will be worn for the away games. However, each player should bring both uniforms to every game. If the referee determines that the team’s uniforms are too similar, then the home team will be required to change uniforms.
- All uniform kits (socks, shorts, jersey’s) must be purchased from the MASC authorized retailer. The cost of the uniform kit is not included and therefore separate and additional to the registration fees.

- Player names are allowed on the back of the uniform jersey.
- No other logos or sponsorship signs will be allowed on any portion of the uniform kit. Including socks, shorts, or jerseys.
- Competition play requires that each player be identified with a distinct number for statistical and disciplinary purposes. Identical numbers on the same team is not permitted. The assignment of the jersey numbers is at the discretion of the team coaches. The MASC uniform supplier is responsible for applying the numbers to all jerseys.
- The manufacturer, model, style, and supplier of the uniforms are determined by the MASC Board of Directors and are subject to change based on contracts. Where there is a transition to a different supplier, the MASC Board of Directors will determine whether traveling teams will have the option to stay with the uniform originally supplied.
- The traveling team coaches will be required to complete their uniform order as per the process prescribed by the MASC Uniform Supplier. No exceptions will be made to this process.
- All issues relating to the supply of uniforms for the traveling teams must be dealt directly with the MASC uniform supplier by the team coaches.

5. Additional Guidelines

- Player and Coaches are expected to take pride in their appearance when representing MASC.

- No MASC team will be allowed to self-produce MASC branded apparel at any time without the approval of the MASC Board.
- Any Reproduction of the MASC logo is strictly prohibited, unless consent has been given by the MASC Board.
- Only players with a current MASC issued player card are allowed to wear the MASC logoed jerseys for tournament play.
